Our main missions are:

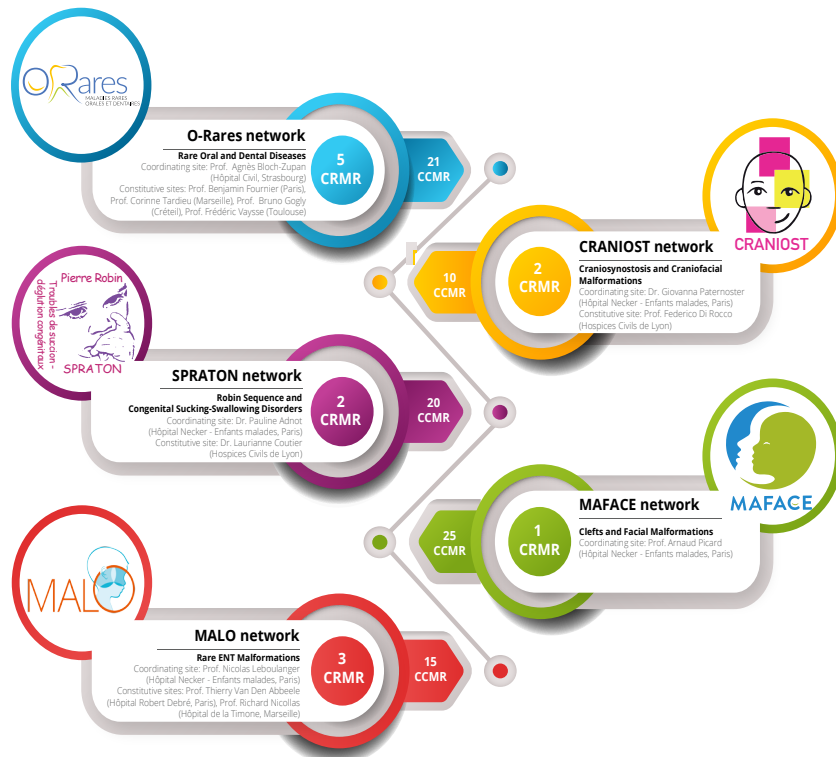
Improve care pathways

Foster European and International collaborations

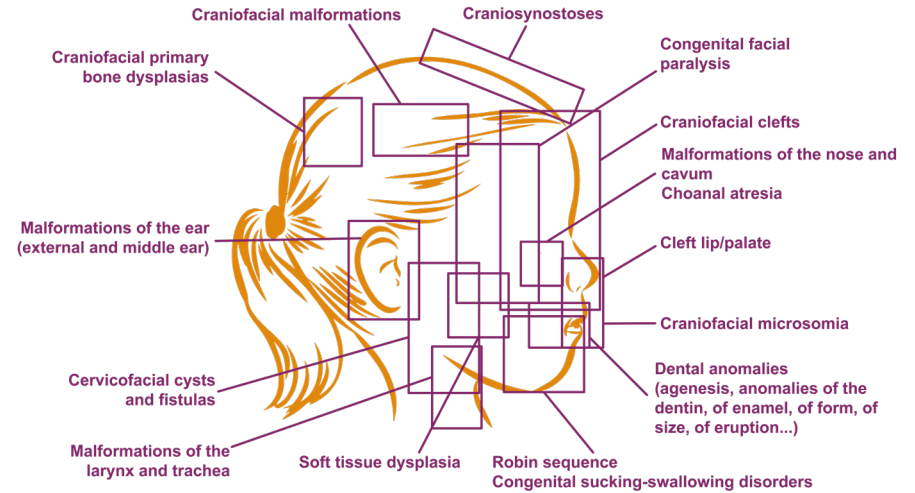
