

The workshop is organized by the French Reference Center for Craniosynostoses and Craniofacial Malformations (CRANIOST), in collaboration with an international expert committee.

In 2026, the workshop will allow craniofacial surgeons to learn unicoronal craniosynostosis correction procedures, and how to manage hypertelorism.

- Year 2027: monobloc advancement
